

*The rule of 3 - linking three feelings, actions, events in one sentence to add interest. *Adverbs and adjectives in your

sentence.

*Long and short sentences.

*Use your senses, to say what you or the child are experiencing in the scene.

ISPACED

Remember, to add interest to our work we can use different sentence starters.

- I An 'ing' word. Use a verb with ing on the end to start the sentence
- S Simile. 'Like' / 'As'
- P Preposition
- A Adverb. Describes an action.
- C Connective although, however, despite, instead
- E An 'ed' word
- D Dialogue (speech)
- Examples of the rule of three:

As I stood there, (1) my heart started to pound, (2) my eyes widened and (3)a bead of sweat trickled down my cheek.

(1)Outside, cars stood frozen in time and (2) fumes filled the air, as (3) I stared at the rain falling from the sky.
