I hope you and your families are well and have been able to enjoy some of the warm Spring weather. We are missing the children but hope that you are keeping healthy and active.

### **Remote learning**

We have activated some other functions in Purple Mash. Pupils will be able to use the '2email' tool on Purple Mash from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> May. This is for pupils to communicate with their class teacher. It may be used for asking any questions pupils have about their home learning and to attach any home learning documents. We are really looking forward to hearing from the children. I know that some of the teachers have recorded messages for the children too.

We request that parents use the Admin email if you any general queries or questions and we will get back to you as soon as we can.

As a school we have invested in Tapestry, Purple Mash, My Maths and Times Tables Rock Stars as some of our online learning activities. We have been researching other appropriate online tools to use as a whole school. I have discussed the way forward with the team and we have decided that we will be adding Google Suite and its education tools in the future. Work will begin on rolling this out shortly. We will share with parents how it will be used for remote learning when it is up and running. I hope that we may be able to build in sessions for teachers to have a weekly Q&A session with pupils. In the meantime, I know that teachers have been providing feedback on Purple Mash.

We will continue to have a good blend of physical, creative and learning activities for the pupils.



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## **Letter writing**

I have heard that some of our children have been very busy writing letters to residents in care homes to brighten their day during lockdown. What a wonderful idea! Well done to all of you who have been doing something positive for others at this time. I know that some of the children have written to all sorts of ordinary and well-known people and had some wonderful replies back. There have been some wonderful acts of kindness.
