### School curriculum and information

#### **Christmas Tree**

Last month, we were asked whether our school would like to take part in an initiative, alongside other schools in the area by Basingstoke & Deane Council. The initiative was to decorate a 'handmade' wooden tree and once decorated, it would be displayed in Festival Place,



Basingstoke over the Christmas period.

After the display, the trees will be taken to local carehomes and hospitals to share with residents and patients. Each child in the school drew their own hands and decorated the trees with designs representing the school values around friendship, peace and love. The decorations were positioned around the tree and a beautiful handmade star, made by Judy, one of our school volunteers was placed on the top.
