For some, this was their first experience at representing our school in an event and for the majority, it was their first experience of cross -country.

There were a total of 174 runners across the three age groups from schools across East Hampshire at this event.

Four of our runners finished in the top 10 for their year groups events - Freddie W, Poppy Olivia and Lily.

The top 12 boys and top 12 girls from the Year 5 and 6 races will go on to represent East Hampshire at the County Cross Country Final on Tuesday 7th March at Down Grange, Basingstoke.

A big well done to everyone who took part, also to Lily who qualified for the next stage in March!
