The RE focus across the School this month has been about holy week and Easter.

In Wrens, we explored the question "why do Christians put a cross in an Easter garden"? We discussed the palm cross and why it is a special symbol, as well as looking at other different symbols associated with Easter. We also looked at resurrection eggs to find out about the Easter story. We then drew our own Easter garden and talked about our own Easter traditions that we are looking forward to, such as an Easter egg hunt and

Robins class have been looking at the idea of 'Salvation' within RE lessons, discussing the events of Holy Week and their significance to Christians. We have also been exploring how some Christians use a Paschal Candle ritual during the Easter period. In DT lessons, pupils have been brushing up on their sewing skills in order to design and create an Easter scene using applique.

In Kingfisher class, the children worked in small groups to read and discuss different statements people might make about the resurrection. They then sorted these into groups "statements a Christian might say" and "what others might say". They were then challenged to share their own beliefs and opinions about the resurrection and listen to the views of others with respect.

On Tuesday, our children visited our local church for an Easter Service planned by the school. The children read carefully, sang beautifully and were extremely well behaved. It was lovely that a number of parents and families attended the service.


