They have also been identifying and naming a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. This was brought to life through a visit from Zoolab. In an interactive workshop, the children met a variety of animals and use their knowledge about them to identify whether they were a mammal, reptile or amphibian. The children were able to confidently identify the range of animals and we discovered that the snake and tarantula were both carnivores, whereas the cockroach was an omnivore. The children were able to touch the animals if they wished and many were surprised at how the snake was not at all slimy like they had thought it would be!
