Please may we ask that all children in KS2 have a named pencil case, <u>small enough to fit into a tray drawer</u> and on their desks. Some of the pencil cases are very large and children need enough desk space to position their exercise books and other resources.

School Uniform

Our school uniform has been carefully chosen to help children feel part of the school community and give a strong sense of identity. It is important that additional accessories such as jewellery, colourful hair bands, extensions, nail varnish/make up are not worn to school. Please also make sure your child wears appropriate school shoes, especially with the wet weather we are experiencing.

Watches are allowed as are small studded earrings but earrings should not be worn on PE days. Long and shoulder length hair should always be tied back. Wearable tech such as smart watches with recorders or cameras are not allowed in school.

Please may we ask that **all school uniform is named**, including, bags, outdoor coats and water bottles that are brought into school.

PE Kit

Please make sure your child has a PE kit with them every day and every item should be named. Pupils may wear plain, dark jogging bottoms outside in colder weather.
